



PUPIL PREMIUM FUNDING 2017-18

In the current **financial year** 2017-2018 Thomson House School has been allocated pupil premium funding of **£15,500**.

Please see below how we intend to spend this allocation during the **academic year** 2017-18:

<u>Area of Support</u>	<u>Description</u>	<u>Cost</u>	<u>Impact on PPG Children</u>
Music Lessons	PPG children who have been identified as having musical talent will have individual weekly piano lessons. Keyboards for home use will also be supplied to those PPG children having piano lessons.	£2,000	PPG children have improved their musical abilities, have increased self-esteem and greater confidence due to performing in 1:1 lessons, weekly assemblies and larger concert performances.
Uniform	The school helps financially towards the cost of purchasing school uniform including PE kit, backpack etc.	£1,000	PPG children are fully included in school life. There is no external indication of deprivation and all children pride themselves of being part of the THS community.
Lunches	At THS all children have school lunches. The school helps financially towards the cost of lunches so all PPG are included in the lunch time experience.	£1,000	All pupils at THS have school lunches – any allergies or religious observances are catered for. Hot school lunches are offered to all PPG children to ensure they have a nutritiously balanced and varied diet and are fully included in school life.
Academic Support	One to one support/small group support, out of class, from SLT in Reading, Writing & Maths.	£2,500	100% of Year 1 PPG are working at ARE and successfully passed the phonics screening check. PPG children are fully immersed in the curriculum and additional support is provided to support PPG children to reach the expected standard.
Enrichment	Extra-curricular clubs, such as football, drama, yoga, chess, to enrich children's education.	£4,000	PPG children are fully included in school life. All PPG children are invited to participate in at least one extra-curricular club, often more – this enriches their education and social interactions at THS.
Challenge	Employment of a part-time assistant teacher to lead challenge groups for the academically more able PPG.	£1,500	100% of PPG children achieving GD at KS1, continue to achieve GD through Years 3 and 4. Proactive and timely intervention ensured that PPG children have the necessary skills to cope when challenged and learning new concepts.
Emotional Support	Employment of a part-time assistant teacher to facilitate the building of self-esteem, resilience and confidence.	£2,000	PPG children across the school have greater levels of confidence, increased resilience and higher levels of self-esteem as a result.
Physical Development	The school will provide bikes for PPG to learn to ride and cycle to and from school. Scooting lessons for all.	£1,500	100% success rate - increased physical activity and cycling skills. No PPG children at THS have childhood obesity.
