

## **PUPIL PREMIUM FUNDING 2016-17**

In the **financial year** 2016-2017 Thomson House School was allocated pupil premium funding of **£13,600**.

Please see below how we spent this allocation during the **academic year** 2016-17:

Area of Support	<u>Description</u>	Cost	Impact on PPG Children
Music Lessons	PPG children who have been identified as having musical talent will have individual weekly piano lessons. Keyboards for home use will also be supplied to those PPG children having piano lessons.	£1,500	PPG children's musical skills/abilities have increased. Their performances in weekly assemblies have built confidence and selfesteem.
Uniform	The school helps financially towards the cost of purchasing school uniform including PE kit, backpack etc.	£800	PPG children are fully included in school life. There is no external indication of deprivation.
Lunches	The school helps financially towards the cost of school lunches so all PPG are included in the lunch time experience.	£500	PPG children are fully included in school life. All pupils at THS have school lunch – any allergies or religious observances are catered for.
Literacy/Numeracy	One to one support, out of class led by specialist teacher in literary/maths skills.	£2,600	100% of Y2 PPG children are working at the Expected Standard or above in Reading, Writing and Maths. 100% of YR PPG children attained a Good Level of Development.
Enrichment	Extra-curricular clubs, such as football, drama, yoga, chess, to enrich children's education.	£3,000	PPG children are fully included in school life. All PPG children participate in at least one extracurricular club, often more – this enriches their education at THS.
Learning Support	Employment of a part-time assistant teacher to lead challenge groups for the academically more able.	£2,600	60% of Y2 PPG children attained Greater Depth in Reading & Maths. 40% of Y2 PPG children attained Greater Depth in Writing.
Emotional Support	Employment of a part-time assistant teacher to facilitate the building of self-esteem, resilience and confidence.	£2,600	PPG children across the school have greater levels of confidence, increased resilience and higher levels of self-esteem as a result.
